Respect and Protect Intellectual Property

- I will follow copyright laws and credit my sources correctly.

Respect and Protect Property

- I will use all tech tools and equipment carefully and not damage, change, or tamper with them.
- I will report abuse of technology to the teacher or principal.

TECHNOLOGY USE AGREEMENT

The Board makes every effort to safeguard students from inappropriate content, and provides education and supervision to ensure students understand and comply with the safe, legal, and responsible use of technology and the information accessed by its use.

This Technology Use Agreement applies to student use of technology.

Student Agreement:

1. I have read and I understand the terms of this Moose Factory Island District School Area Board agreement.
2. I will use the internet and networks for educational purposes only.
3. I understand that use of the internet for the following purposes is specifically prohibited:
 - to access resources or data of others for any purpose without authorization, including passwords, files or tapes, whether at school or elsewhere;
 - to send messages or files containing digital information likely to result in loss or disruption of the recipient's work or system ("viruses"), or to load such messages or files onto the networks;
 - to transfer commercial software, materials protected by trade secret, or other copyright protected material;
 - to commit any illegal act;
 - to intentionally obtain or to send materials which are or might be considered inappropriate, obscene, abusive, offensive, harassing, bullying, or illegal;
 - to obtain or attempt to obtain any material or item prohibited by the Board; and
 - to use the networks for commercial purposes, or for games.
4. I agree that the principal will be the initial decision-maker about the materials which are or might be considered inappropriate, obscene, abusive, offensive, harassing, bullying, or illegal, or what constitutes any other violation of these rules, and that any appeal will be to the appropriate superintendent.
5. I understand that penalties for violation of these rules may include temporary or permanent withdrawal of network computer privileges, suspension from school, and/or prosecution under the law.
