NOTICE TO COMMUNITY RESIDENTS **MINISTIK SCHOOL REVERTING TO PHASE ONE: REMOTE AT-HOME LEARNING –** **from Tuesday, April 27, 2021**

As you are aware, the Ministry of Education has made the decision to move all schools in Ontario to remote learning following the Spring Break as part of the Stay-At-Home Order. There have been many challenges faced by families, students and staff and we wish to say Meegwetch for your continued support and patience as we navigate through the changing landscape.

As we move into full remote learning after the Spring Break, please review the following communication closely, which outlines important information regarding plans for students to engage in remote learning next week.

On Tuesday, April 27, Moose Factory Ministik School will revert to **Phase One: Remote At-Home Learning (full time)**

Technology Distribution

We realize that some students will need to borrow a device from the school in order to learn from home. If your child has no access to a device for at-home learning, please share this with your child's teacher. We will do our best to distribute available devices as soon as possible.

Online Learning Resources

The Ministry of Education recently announced the launch of a new portal, TVO Learn, which provides supports for students learning remotely by accessing additional educational resources developed by Ontario certified teachers.

It is our understanding that **the Stay-At-Home order is in effect until May 20, 2021 and we expect this** **remote learning plan to remain in effect until that time.**

We will continue to provide updates as we learn more.
